# **Middle School English**

#### Overview

Students will have the opportunity to communicate their preferred methodologies throughout the course, which will help them understand, develop, and execute their learning strategy.

- Appreciate the features of language and how they can be used to influence purpose and audience
- Develop various writing styles and improve knowledge of the tools used in writing to create meaning
- Promote understanding of how English is used to communicate in different contexts

  - Set SMART goals
  - Develop a personalised curriculum with an associated timeline based on a specific set of goals.
- Develop reading skills
  - Challenging texts

- Practice writing in a variety of styles
  - o Persuasive essay, narrative, informative essay, etc.
- Improve listening and speaking skills through interactive activities
  - o E.g., Debates
- Use real-world examples to demonstrate the importance of language in our lives
  - Investigate a variety of texts in order to critically analyse and understand how language is used to convey different purposes to a range of audiences
- Expand vocabulary
- Role reversal to test understanding of skills
