

A Level Business

Overview

Students enrolled in this program will enhance their understanding of the nature and scope of business in society. Students will work with one of our mentors during this program to develop their business knowledge, with the aim of applying it to a wide variety of current business situations around the world. Over the course of the program, students will delve into subjects such as economics, environmental, ethical, governmental, legal, social and technological issues as well as understanding organisation culture. Mentors will supplement student learning through discussion of the various factors influencing business decision making, and through the analysis of case studies which will foster the critical thinking and evaluation skills needed to communicate effective arguments.
