Students will cultivate the skill set needed to deliver and interpret verbal and nonverbal messages. Students will master an array of research methods that can apply to public speaking as well as other academic and social spaces. Moreover, students will have the opportunity to sharpen their critical thinking and listening skills while preparing for speeches, and while being the audience for others. Furthermore, students will develop the self-awareness to understand their habits whilst speaking amongst an audience. Lastly, students will be challenged by monthly goals that the he/she and the instructor will work towards.
