Overview

In this program, students will work on developing a more comprehensive understanding of the theory and concepts of accounting. As they work with a mentor to identify their strengths and weaknesses, students will learn the ways that accounting is used in a wide range of economic and business contexts. In doing so, students will develop their accounting vernacular. Over the course of this program, our mentor will prioritise the enhancement of your child's critical thinking so that they will be better equipped to analyse and evaluate information before presenting it in an appropriate accounting form.

Objectives

- Develop knowledge and understanding of the principles and purposes of accounting
- Enhance numeracy, literacy, communication, enquiry, and interpretation skills
- Provide students with a core knowledge of accounting
- Improve presentation skills

Structure

- Reflect on current knowledge of the range of topics that Accounting covers and identify strengths and weaknesses
 - Develop a personalised curriculum
- Outline the most common questions in Paper 2 and provide sample model answers
- Learn to critically analyse and accurately present textual evidence
- Review key points of analysis and discussion
- Build on knowledge and understanding of accounting in the various topics
 - Fundamentals of accounting, sources and recording of data, verification of accounting records, accounting procedures, preparation of financial statements, accounting principles and policies
- Collaboratively develop data analysis skills
 - Question reliability and validity of data to improve critical thinking
